Monday, September 28, 7 a.m. through Wednesday, September 30, 2 p.m.

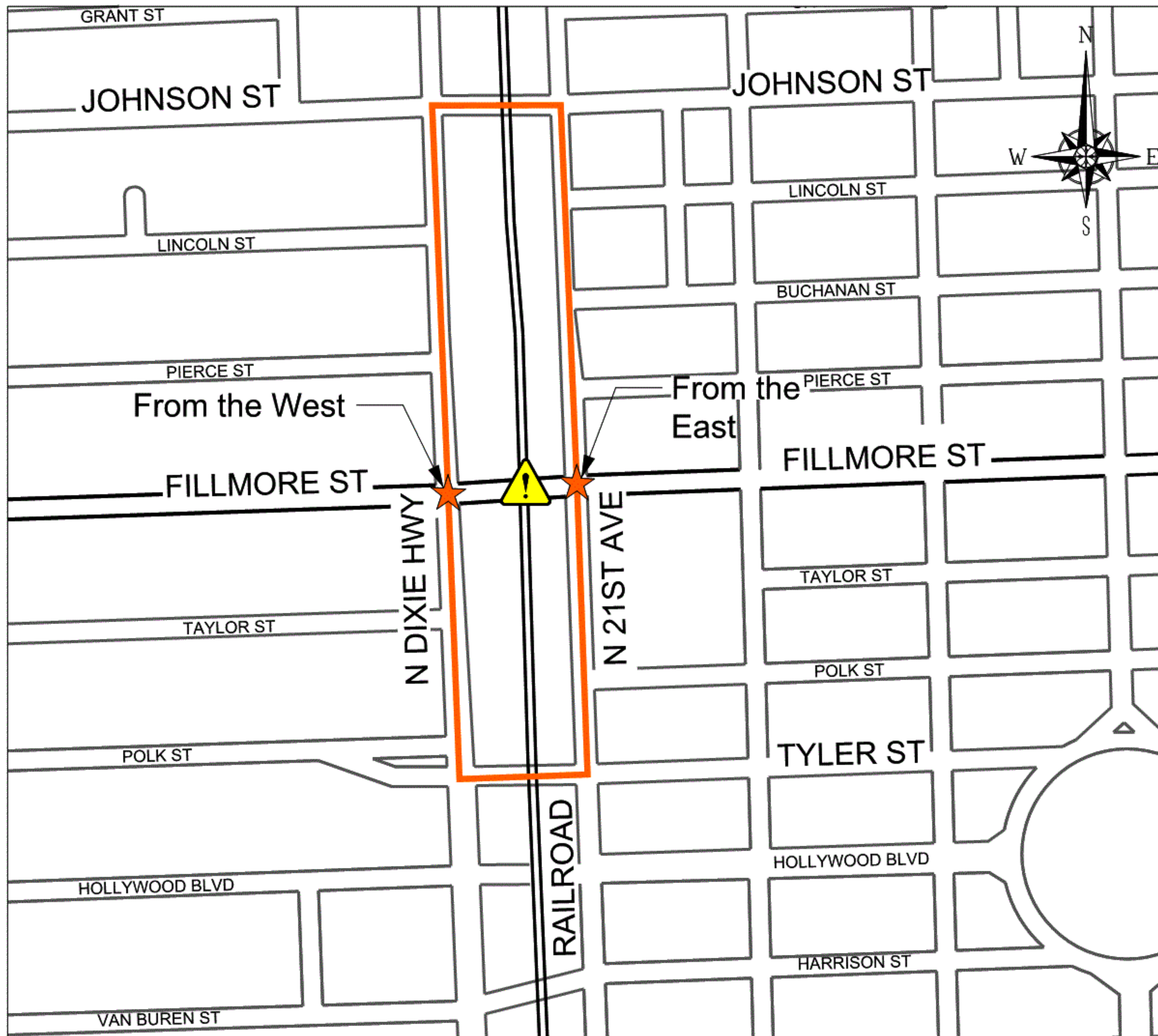

Fillmore Street Hollywood






From the East:

Travel south on North Dixie Highway, east on Tyler Street and north on North 21st Avenue to return to Fillmore Street.
