### **ALL ABOARD FLORIDA TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE NW 10<sup>th</sup> STREET & NW 11<sup>th</sup> STREET IN THE CITY OF MIAMI**

**WHAT:** Crews working for All Aboard Florida, the express intercity passenger rail service owned by Florida East Coast Industries, will temporarily close the intersections of NW 10<sup>th</sup> Street and NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street and the Florida East Coast Railway in order to work on sections of the railroad tracks.

The intersections will be closed at 6 a.m. on Friday, August 21, and reopen at approximately 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, August 23. Crews from the locally-owned company Gonzalez & Sons will be installing a new railroad track panel and about 120 feet of new track parallel to the existing track. This work is necessary to keep freight rail operations going as All Aboard Florida constructs MiamiCentral, the new passenger rail station in downtown Miami.

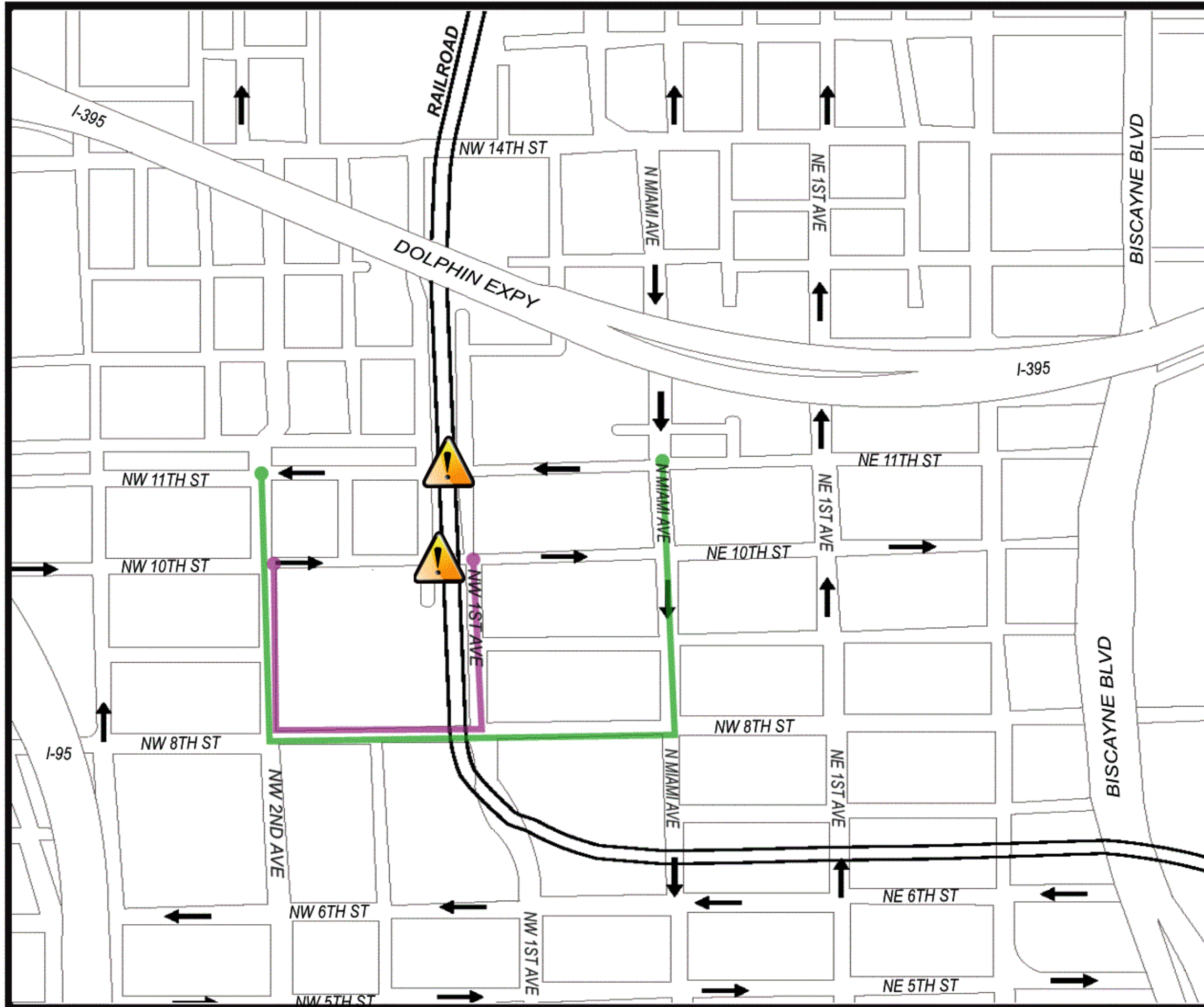
#### **ABOUT ALL ABOARD FLORIDA**

### Detour:

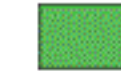
(Temporary Closures to Occur Simultaneously)

#### 10th Street:



Travel south on NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, east on NW 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and north on NW 1st Avenue to return to NE 10th Street.

#### 11th Street:



Travel south on N Miami Avenue, west on NW 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and north on NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to return to NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street.
